

## **Czech and Slovakian League in Cowboy Action Shooting - Rules**

Organized by Asociace westernových střelců (AWS) and Slovenská asociácia westernovej strel'by (SAWS)

#### 1) Number of matches, rules

Czech and Slovakian League in Cowboy Action Shooting (league) will consist of six matches. These include national championships of the organizing countries. The whole league will be shot in accordance with SASS rules.

#### 2) Location

Each country will organize the same number of matches. Three matches will be organized in the Czech Republic and three matches in the Slovak Republic.

Dates and locations of the matches will be published on the organizers' web sites.

#### 3) Main matches and side matches

The league matches will include action shooting and precision shooting.

Cowboy Action Shooting will constitute the main match. SASS categories will apply in the main match and there is no minimum number of shooters rule for each category.

Precision shooting (long range) include LA rifle for pistol cartridge, long range single shot rifle for rifle cartridge and muzzle loading rifle. Muzzle loading rifle will be shot 10 rounds in 15 minutes to the maximum distance of 100 meters.

#### 4) Minimum number of stages per match

Every league match has to consist of at least ten stages of the main match. National championships will be organized for two or more days. The other league matches will be organized for maximum of two days (Saturday and Sunday).

#### 5) Participation of shooters who are not SAWS/AWS members

Czech and Slovakian League is open also for all shooters who are not SAWS/AWS members.

## 6) Match fees

Match fees for national championships will be determined by the organizers. For the other league matches the fee for AWS/SAWS member will be in the amount of EUR 20 (junior: EUR 10). The fee on these matches for shooter who is not AWS/SAWS member will be in the amount of EUR 30 (junior: EUR 15). This does not apply to national championships where the fee will be in the same amount for all shooters.

## 7) Scoring of individual matches

Scoring by rank will be used for every league main match. Precision shooting will be scored based on the total of achieved points, where the shooter on the first place will get one point, shooter on second place will get two points and so on. The shooter with the lowest number of points will be the league winner.

## 8) Scoring of the league

Every shooter will get the number of points that equals his resulting position in his category, i.e. the shooter on the first place will get one point, shooter on second place will get two points and so on. The shooter with the lowest number of points will be the league winner for his category.

The same applies for overall scoring. Each shooter will get the number of points that equals to his overall position.

In case that two or more shooters achieve the same amount of points the totals of their times from matches to which they all participated will be compared.

The prerequisite for participation in the league a shooter has to shoot minimum four matches, out of which two must be in the Czech Republic and two in the Slovak Republic. All matches have to be shot in the same category.

Out of the six league matches the best four will be used in the league evaluation.

## 9) Continuous preparation and publishing of actual results

During the league the results of individual matches and the actual league results will be published on the AWS/SAWS websites.

The league results will always be updated by the organizer of the most recent league match.

Both organizers will use the same software for evaluation of the league matches and the total league results.

#### 10) Prizes and awards

Value of the prizes for the national championships is upon the organizers' decision.

Provision of prizes for the final evaluation of the whole league will be done by mutual cooperation of both organizers. However, the main party responsible for provision of the prizes is the one organizing the last league match. This will be alternating every year between the Czech Republic and the Slovak Republic.

The amount determined for prizes will be set as follows:

Out of the match fee collected on the league matches 10% will be determined for prizes. For national championships, EUR 20 out of every match fee paid per head will be considered as league match fee. 10% out of this value will then be considered as a contribution to the league prizes' cost.

Example:

**a/ 80 shooters will shoot the national championships. The match fee is EUR 50. Out of the EUR 50 the amount of EUR 20 is considered to be a league match fee. Therefore the part used for acquisition of league prizes will be  $80 \times 20 = 1600 \times 10\% = \text{EUR } 160$ .**

**b/ 2000 EUR will be collected as a match fee on a league match. 10% out of this amount, i.e. EUR 200, will be used for acquisition of league prizes.**

#### 11) Location and date of the final award ceremony

The league will be evaluated and awards given after and at the location of the final league match.
